

I invite you to consider the **14,000,000** Jewish people living today - the vast majority of which do not know the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob because they do not know Jesus - Jehovah manifest in the flesh. Like the apostle Paul, "...my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they might be saved." - Romans 10: 1

There are currently **5,700,000** sons and daughters of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob — residing in the U.S. Most of these have little to no gospel witness. Most of them will die without ever hearing the truth about Jesus. **Most will spend an eternity in hell, because no one bothered to explain to them how their Messiah already came. Will their blood will be on our hands?** Statistically, 2 of these whom Jesus called His brethren, pass into eternity every second.

What are we doing to reach them? The Bible says in Romans 10:14, "And how shall they hear without a preacher?"

We are commanded to "Go and teach all nations," but I fear that in our reaching of the uttermost parts of the earth, we have neglected "Jerusalem." In our reaching of those in far off regions, we have abandoned our efforts to reach God's chosen people - the Jews, who are the "apple of God's eye." We as the body of Christ have forsaken the biblical model of taking the gospel "to the Jew first," and have largely substituted it with taking the gospel to the Gentiles ONLY.

This should never be! We need to reach ALL people groups - and in our reaching the uttermost, God forbid we neglect "Jerusalem"- the Jews. The Lord has burdened me with the three following callings:

1. Evangelize the Lost

My goal, as well as the goal of Jewish Awareness Ministries, is to make Jewish people aware of their need for salvation through Jesus, the prophesied Redeemer of Israel. Although the Jewish people are small in number compared to the world population of Gentiles, the fact remains that their relationship with God, and their need for salvation is preeminent in every part of our Bible. It is the heartbeat of God. Paul tells us in Romans 11, (speaking to Gentiles about the Jews), that "thou bearest not the root, but the root thee... For if thou wert cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and wert grafted

contrary to nature into a good olive tree: how much more shall these, which be the natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree? ...For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief: Even so have these also now not believed, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy." -Romans 11:18,24,30,31

We are breaking God's heart, and disobeying His word if we neglect to share the gospel with the Jews.

We are currently endeavoring to share the gospel with Jewish people locally, and across the globe through the following three avenues:

2. Enlist Laborers

Jesus said in Matthew 9:37,38 "The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest" and he also said, "Lift up your eyes, and look unto the fields; for they are white already to harvest" in John 4:35.

Many Bible colleges today are sadly lacking in the area of teaching and preaching on Jewish Evangelism. Our desire is for college students and church workers to be aware of the need. There may be those who are burdened for Jewish people, but never heard of Jewish missions (as was the case with myself as a 17 year old boy).

If the Lord is calling an individual into Jewish missions, we want to help him/her get to the field as soon as possible.

There may be some who are burdened for Jewish ministry, but don't know if full-time missionary work in this field is God's will for their lives. We would desire that they do whatever it is that the Lord has specifically called them to. We can help equip them, so that when and if they do meet a Jewish person in ministry, they would know how to reach them with the gospel.

3. Equip Believers

We are endeavoring to make Christians aware of the necessity and urgency of sharing the gospel with the Jews and to equip them to do it. Our desire is to present this need to as many churches and Bible colleges as we can, to build their love and burden for the Jewish people, and also to teach them how to effectively share their faith with those they may come into contact with. If every born-again believer was aware of the need, and equipped to reach them, many Jewish people who have never heard the gospel would finally hear.

There are many Jewish communities all around this country that a Jewish missionary may never reach, but these same communities are right next door to a Bible-believing church.

If we are going to reach Jesus' brethren with the gospel, it must be done through and with the local church.
