Jesus, the promised Messiah of Israel, the living God of the Old Testament in human form loved His people, wept over them (Luke 19:41), and died for them. John 3:16 - perhaps the most well known verse in the entire Bible was said by our Lord to a Jewish man named Nicodemus. In Matthew 1:1 Jesus is "...the Son of David, the Son of Abraham." If the Jews would only realize who Jesus really is, they would be much closer to receiving Him as Savior.

Did you know that the only literal account in scripture of anyone being in hell is that of a Jewish man? In Luke 16:22-28 we read the words of Jesus, "And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father Abraham... But Abraham said, Son....then he (the rich man) said, I pray thee therefore, father..." The rich man was Jewish. Being God's chosen people does not earn them salvation, as is the misconception of almost all Jews, and sadly, a great deal of "evangelical" Christians.

I graduated with a B.A. in Missions from Pensacola Christian College in 2006, and have served with Jewish Awareness Ministries since 2010 (4 of those years as a missionary to the Jews in Cleveland, Ohio). The Lord has greatly burdened me for the sad state of Jewish missions in our country as well as across the globe.
