

The Millennium Kingdom part 2

2. Purpose

A. Reverse the results of the fall

- 1) Theocracy restored - Zechariah 14:9
(Theocracy lost in the rebellion of Genesis 3)
- 2) God must crush Satan and his kingdom - Revelation 20:1-3
(Satan now ruling as result of the fall in Genesis 3 – cf. 1 John 5:19; John 12:31; 16:11; 2 Cor. 4:3-4; Ephesians 6:12; Luke 4:5-7)
- 3) Curse reversed - Matthew 19:28; Acts 3:21
(Curse established on earth in Genesis 3:17-19)

B. Fulfill the biblical covenants (Abrahamic, Land, Davidic, and New)

- 1) Land - Ezekiel 36:24-28; 47:13 - 48:35
- 2) Seed - Zechariah 12-14
- 3) Blessing - all entering the Millennium are saved (see 3A)

3. People

A. All going into the Kingdom will be saved

- 1) Redeemed Survivors of the Tribulation - Zechariah 12:8-13:1
Matthew 25:31-46



Survivors of the Tribulation entering the Millennium Kingdom will have natural bodies like we do today. They will be marrying and having children during the 1000 years.



Children born in the Millennium need to be saved to go into the eternal kingdom.

- 2) Resurrected Old Testament saints - Daniel 12:2, 13
- 3) Resurrected Tribulation saints - Revelation 20:4
- 4) Resurrected Church-Age saints - 2 Timothy 2:12; 1 Corinthians 6:2

B. Israel will be exalted

- 1) Israel will be glorified - Zechariah 2:6-12; Deuteronomy 28:13; Isaiah 62:1-4
- 2) Israel will be a blessing - Zechariah 8:13
- 3) Israel will lead the world to worship Jehovah - Zechariah 8:18-23

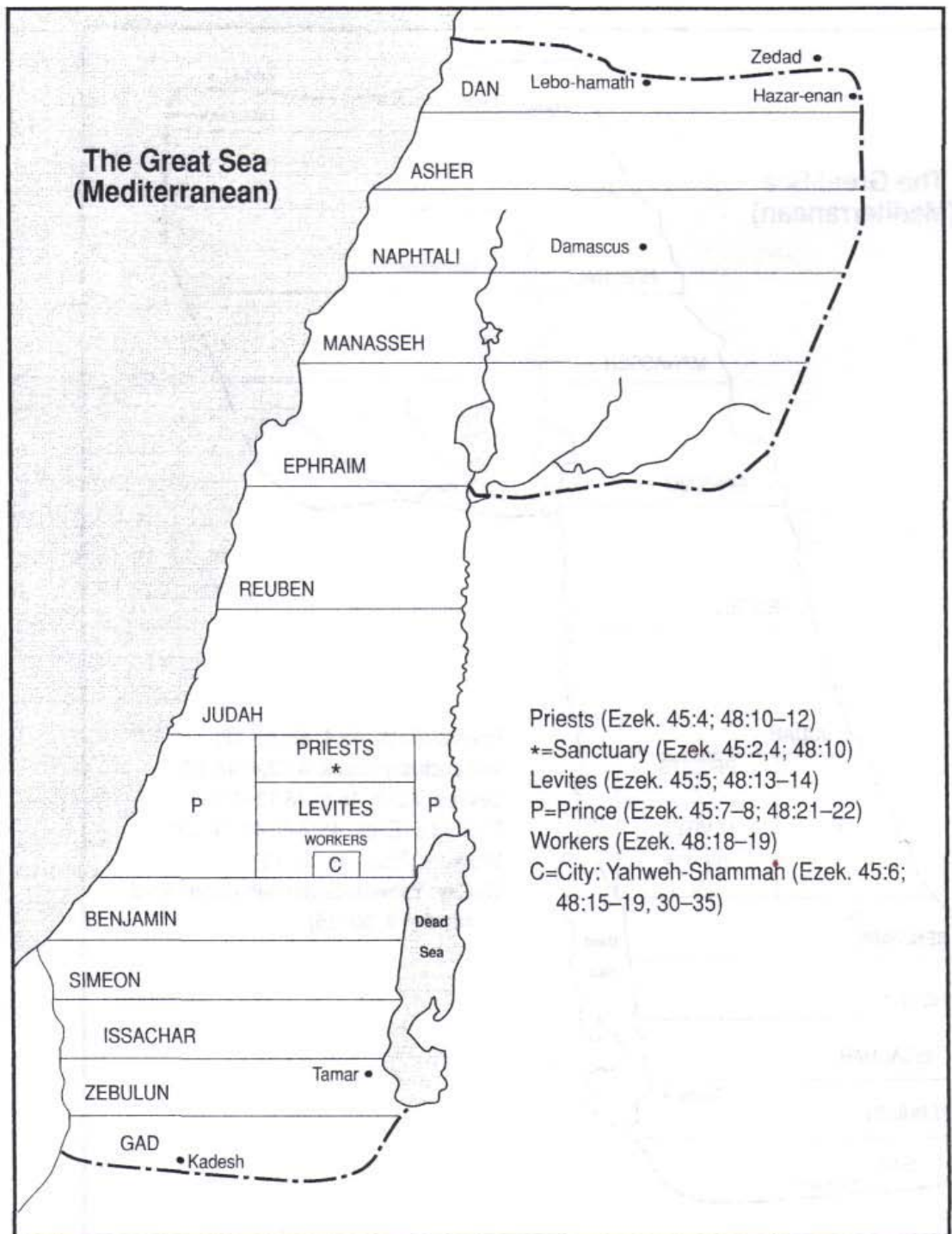


Fig. 10.1 Map of Israel in the Kingdom

The allotments and placement of designated territories are based on Ezekiel 47:13–48:35. Since major topographical changes are expected in preparation for the kingdom (Ezek. 47:1–12), the land area of the allotments can only be estimated.
